### **National League**

Round 2 of the national league saw the club make the trip to Templemore, Tipperary. It was a big ask for the men's team to secure qualification after a poor first round in Tallaght. The men's team were again short on numbers but those that made the trip were competitive in their events. Jamie Pender, fresh off his European junior experience went in the 200m and finished in 3<sup>rd</sup>, Proctor Geoghan went in the 1500m and took 4<sup>th</sup> place, Eoghan Buggy went in the 400m this round and won it comfortably, the same can be said for Cian Kelly who backed up his PB run last weekend with a win in the 800m, Brandon Fennelly was 4<sup>th</sup> in the Hammer, Mark Dowling stepped in for the shot finishing in 6<sup>th</sup>, Aidan Kelly was 4<sup>th</sup> in the Discus and John Territ was 5<sup>th</sup> in the Javelin. The men's team finished with 49 points in the round.

The Ladies team were in strong position to make the final after the Round 1 and put in great team performance to hit 118 point in Templemore. The ladies recorded 6 wins on the day, 3 coming from Saragh Buggy in the long jump, triple jump and 100m hurdles, 1 by Nessa Millet in the 400m hurdles, another by Cheryl Nolan in the 3k and 1 from Nicole Kehoe Dowling in the Discus. Ness Millet also finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the high jump and Nicole was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the shot. Siobhan Nash toggged out for the walk and took 2<sup>nd</sup> place early in the day, Maebh Maher finished in 5<sup>th</sup> in the 1500m with sister Cara 4<sup>th</sup> in the 800m, Lauryn Kealy was 4<sup>th</sup> in 400m and 6<sup>th</sup> in 200m, Ruby Millet was fresh off the plane from Hungary and made it just in time for the 100m where she took 2<sup>nd</sup> place, Emma Daly was 4<sup>th</sup> in the Hammer and the Javelin. The Ladies 4x100 relay was 4<sup>th</sup> while the 4x400m was 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Women's team are in with chance of placing high in the final but will face strong opposition from DSD on the 20<sup>th</sup> August.
