In the inaugural streets of Kilkenny 5k 437 runners took to the Streets and among them were Stephen Hunter who finished 4th in 16.02, Sinead Kelly in 69th place running 20.09, Margo Dowling in 94th with 21.22, Sharon Buggy in 134th place in 22.59, Pauline Doyle who was 351st in 30.48 and Carmel Hughes who placed 363rd in 31.37. Rebecca Fenlon Finished 3rd u18 girls in a time of 21.09.

Linda Ward ran in the Fighting Cocks 10k over the weekend, finishing in 63rd having run 53:30 for the 10k. In the 5k event Peter Baldwin finished 4th in 19.20, Sinead Kelly was 8th in 19.43, Sharon Buggy was 24th in 22.46, Deirdre Brennan was 29th in 23.35, Emma Baldwin was 53rd in 25.47, Mary Boylan finished 54th running 25.47, Sinead Milton came in 71st in 27.10, Pauline Doyle was 104th in 30.31 and Carmel Hughes was 121st in 31.46.

In the Battle of Clontarf 10mile, Catriona McDonald was our sole athlete running. She came home 19th female in time of 1:13.48. State side Cormac Kelly ran 3:54.7 for the 1500m at the Bryan Clay Invitational Meet, Azusa, California. Well done to all.
